6.1 Community Policing Update --- Bob Gowen

- Posts on William Street are dated 1910. This is possible as William Street became a street in 1908.
- She was told she was the only person to bring this up so suggested a letter from the Residents' Association in support of removing signs from the posts be written

It was moved/seconded that a letter be written to City Council with a copy to Roger Emanuels, Coordinator, Transportation Infrastructure, in support of removing signs from the lamp posts to preserve the heritage character of the posts.
